1.	ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: - Candidate should be a citizen of India.
2.	NATIVITY:
i.	Candidate should be a Native of Tamil Nadu.
ii.	Candidates who have studied from VI to XII standards in schools of Tamil Nadu are exempt from producing the “Nativity Certificate”.
iii.	Candidates who are native of Tamil Nadu studied from VI to XII Std. either partly or completely in schools situated outside Tamil Nadu should produce the “Nativity Certificate”.
iv.	Nativity Certificate should be issued by the competent authority in the specified format available in the prospectus ANNEXURE-I.
v.	Application without a proper nativity certificate will not be considered.
vi.	Foreign nationals are NOT eligible to apply for admission to B.N.Y.S. course.
	Note: a) Nativity Certificate should be produced as per instructions for Nativity Certificate in Annexure I. b) Producing false nativity certificate if detected at any time later during the course of study will result in expulsion of the candidate and also initiation of criminal proceedings against the candidate as well as the parents as per law.
3.	AGE LIMIT: Candidates should have completed the age of Seventeen years on or before 31st December 2023. Evidence for the age (e.g., Birth Certificate, 10 th Mark Sheet, +2 Mark Sheet, etc.) should be produced.

4.	<p>EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:</p> <p>i. Candidates should have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination conducted by the Tamil Nadu State Board or any other equivalent Board in the following group of subjects along with English individually.</p> <p>(a) Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. (or)</p> <p>(b) Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any other subject.</p> <p>Note: Candidates who have passed in other board of examination (i.e., other than the Tamil Nadu State Board, CBSE and ISC) with same subjects as mentioned above in clause 4 should produce the Eligibility Certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr.MGR Medical University before attending the Counselling.</p>
ii.	<p>Candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from <i>National Institute of Open Schooling*</i> or <i>State Open Schools*</i> or <i>as private candidates*</i> from recognized State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as an additional subject shall be allowed but subject to the outcome of Special Leave Petitions / Appeals filed by the Medical Council of India. (On par with other AYUSH Courses)</p> <p>Note: <i>*“The proviso in italics has been a subject matter of challenge before the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi, Hon’ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, and Hon’ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. 5.	<p>The following categories of candidates are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for B.N.Y.S. Course.</p>
a.	<p>Candidates who have passed H.Sc. in Vocational Stream, Pre-University Course in Tamil Nadu, and who used scribe, who did not study English as a subject in higher secondary examination.</p>
b.	<p>Candidates presently pursuing the B.N.Y.S. Course are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply during this academic session.</p>
c.	<p>Candidates native of other states and studied in other states.</p>

c.	<p>Normalization of Marks:</p> <p>i) The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authority will be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of Tamil Nadu by adopting the method of normalization.</p> <p>Explanation: - Under the method of normalization, the highest mark obtained by the students of various Boards in each subject will be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of State Board in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject will be determined accordingly.</p> <p>Illustration: - If the highest mark secured by the student of State Board in Physics is 100, and the highest mark secured by the student of any other Board in the same subject is 90, both the highest mark will be considered to be equal to 100. If the student of the Other Board secures 60 marks in Physics when the highest mark in Physics in the same board is 90, the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived at below: -</p> $100 \times 60/90 = 66.66\%$ <p>ii) After normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by different Boards, the qualified students of different Boards will be merged into a common merit list.</p>
d.	<p>Determination of Rank of Candidates Obtaining Equal Marks (Inter Se Merit):</p> <p>In cases, where two or more candidates obtain equal aggregated marks for 200, the rank of such candidates shall be determined on the basis of the following order, namely:</p> <p>(i) Percentage in Biology or Botany and Zoology taken together in qualifying examination.</p> <p>(ii) Percentage in Chemistry in qualifying examination.</p> <p>(iii) Percentage in fourth optional subject in qualifying examination.</p> <p>(iv) Date of Birth- Weightage given to seniority in age</p> <p>(v) Computerized Random number assigned. Higher value of Random Number will be taken into Consideration.</p>
11.	The merit list will be published on the notice board at the office of the Selection Committee and will be posted simultaneously on the website: www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in

12.	<p>The selection will be made by counselling based on the merit and applying rule of reservation as laid down by the Government of Tamil Nadu. i.	<p>a) Selection committee is the designated authority for counselling for admissions to BNYS course in all Government and Self-Financing Yoga and Naturopathy Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu.</p>												
	<p>b) No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the undergraduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by Selection committee in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged.</p>												
ii.	<p>Selection will be made by counselling based on merit and duly applying the rule of reservation followed by the Government of Tamil Nadu.</p>												
iii.	<p>All Communication regarding Counselling will be displayed / available through the official website only and any change or modification and relevant information pertaining to this admission process will be made available on the website www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in.</p>												

iv.a.	The candidates are instructed to visit the website at least two times a day for updates from the date of issue of application till the end of admission process without fail. Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of notices, notification and publications appearing on the website regarding admission to B.N.Y.S. Course 2023-2024 Session.

v.	One of the Parents or Guardian will be allowed to accompany the candidate to attend the counselling and they should make their own arrangements for attending the counselling session.

<p><i>i.</i></p>	<p>General counselling:</p> <p>Selection will be made by counselling based on merit and duly applying the rule of reservation followed by the Government of Tamil Nadu.</p> <p>a) The candidate is eligible to opt either a Government or a Self-financing college based on his/her eligibility. If there is no vacancy in the Government college at his/her turn, he/she can opt to be waitlisted for Government College alone. Likewise, if there is no vacancy both in the Government and in any of the Self-financing colleges, then he/she can opt to be waitlisted for both Government and Self-financing colleges. However, candidates cannot opt to be waitlisted for a particular college, when the seats are available in other colleges for the particular Community at his/ her turn.</p> <p>b) Candidates can select a college of their own choice at the time of counselling. However, the allotment is subject to availability of the seats. If a candidate chooses a Government quota seat in Self-Financing College when seats are available in Government College, he/she has to give a Declaration to the effect that he/ she will not claim the Government seat later during re-allotment / subsequent phases of counselling.</p> <p>c) Option once exercised during counselling, will be final and cannot be changed.</p> <p>d) Those who get Re-totaled / revalued marks during the first appearance can also attend the counselling on the day and session according to their new marks. If the candidate produces the Re-totaled / revalued marks after the counselling and within the cut-off date then his/her name, will be considered only in the existing vacancies available and he/she cannot claim any preferential rights for allotment according to merit under re-totaled / revalued marks. <p><i>i.</i></p>	<p>Candidates who fails to attend the counselling schedule stipulated to them, as per their turn, for whatsoever reasons, will be given a seat in the existing vacancies available in any one of the colleges irrespective of their merit of marks, within the same phase of counselling.</p>
<p><i>ii.</i></p>	<p>Candidates getting allotment through court orders before the cut-off date will be given a seat in the existing vacancies available at the time of counselling when he/she actually attends.</p>

iii.	Candidates who fail to attend the counselling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission and their names will not be considered at later phase of Counselling. However, he/she can authorize his/her parent on his/her behalf for that phase of counselling due to any unavoidable circumstances. The parents' decision will be binding on the candidate. An authorization letter given by the candidate should be submitted by the parents along with the original documents of any one of the identification proofs such as Voter ID, driving license, Pan card, Passport, Aadhar card, etc. of both the parent and the candidate as mentioned in the annexure VIII and VIII (A). Due to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances, if a candidate, his/her parents/guardian could not attend the counselling on the specified date and time, the candidate will be permitted to attend the counselling on the subsequent date in the same phase of counselling and he/she can only opt for the seats available at the time of counselling and cannot claim seat as per his/her rank.
iv.	Those who do not join within the stipulated time to the particular college, to which they are allotted, will not be considered for admission at any point of time later.
v.	No candidate can opt to be waitlisted for a particular college when seats are available in other colleges for the particular Community at his/ her turn.
vi.	If a candidate opts out of (not willing to take) either Government / other category of seats, when seats are available at the time of his / her counselling, then he/she will not be eligible for the same seat at any point of time later for whatsoever reason.
vii.	Individual request for transfer of college will not be entertained after allotment of seat is made.
viii.	Mutual transfers will not be entertained under any circumstances.
ix.	Any remaining unfilled seats for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to SCA communities shall be filled by candidates belonging to SC community other than Arunthathiyars as per merit and vice versa
x.	Any remaining reserved seats in ST quota for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to ST community shall be allotted to candidates belonging to SC community as per merit
xi.	Any remaining unfilled seats in BC(M) Community for want of adequate number of eligible candidates after exhausting the merit list shall be filled up on merit basis by candidates belonging to BC community without exceeding the quota for BC community as a whole.

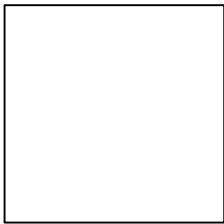

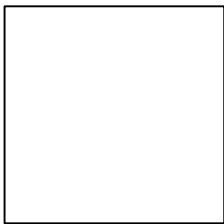
