**Counseling for M.D. Yoga & Naturopathy PG Medical Degree Course  
For the Academic year 2023-24.**

**Instructions to the Candidates:**

1. The Entrance Examination for admission to the Post Graduate Course in M.D. in Yoga and Naturopathy for the academic year 2023-2024 has been scheduled to be conducted on 07.12.2023 at 9.30 A. M. as per the approved Prospectus.
2. **The Entrance Examination Venue** is at Government Siddha Medical College, Arignar Anna Govt. Hospital of Indian Medicine Campus, Arumbakkam, Chennai – 600 106.
3. The Entrance Examination for admission to the Post Graduate M.D. (Yoga & Naturopathy) course will be conducted as per existing Curriculum / Syllabus of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M. G. R. Medical University for BNYS Medical Degree Course.
4. **The Entrance Examination** will be covering all subjects and will contain **200 Objective type questions** each with four responses (A, B, C, D) in English.
5. Admission to the course will be made purely on merit, based on the marks obtained in the entrance Examination.
6. Candidate should collect the Hall Ticket half an hour before at the time of examination. Candidates will not be allowed to appear for the Entrance Examination unless he / she holds the Hall Ticket.
7. Candidate should bring any Identity Card (Aadhar Card, Voter ID, Driving License, or any other valid ID card with Photo) at the time of examination.
8. The Hall Superintendent will verify the identity of the examinee with reference to his/her photograph affixed on the Identification card.
9. Candidates appearing for Entrance Examination will have to come to the Examination center at their own expense and make their own arrangements for stay.
10. Candidates should be present and seated in their allotted place as per

their Application Register number, thirty minutes prior to the commencement of examination in order to fill up all examination particulars and identification verification.

11. Candidates coming 30 minutes after the commencement of the examination will not be permitted to take the examination.
12. No candidate shall be allowed to carry any textual materials printed or written bits of paper, electronic and telecommunication gadgets and devices with or without remote sensing like cellular phones, Pen scanners or electronic diary, Smart Watches etc. inside the examination hall.
13. No candidate shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the end of half an hour after opening of question papers or one hour after commencement. Candidates shall not leave their seats even for using the Restroom without permission. Frequent visits to restroom may be avoided. Once a candidate leaves the Hall for any other reasons, he/she will not be permitted to re-enter the hall.
14. Candidate shall maintain strict silence in the examination hall. Any misconduct found out by the Hall Superintendent will result in the forfeiture of the right to continue the examination. His/ Her answer sheets will not be considered for valuation. Further he/she will not be allowed to apply for the PG course for two consecutive years. The decision of the Hall Superintendent in this connection shall be final.
15. Answers should be shaded with their blue or black ball pen (NOT GEL), in the OMR sheets as per the instructions given in the OMR Sheet. There will be no rechecking, revaluation or recount of answer sheets. The Selection Committee's decision in this matter is final.
16. The Question paper, Blank sheets (if any), OMR answer sheets, etc. are the property of the Committee and no part or whole shall be retained by a candidate under any circumstances. Any attempt to retain or take away these materials by a candidate shall be construed as serious misconduct and the candidate will be immediately disqualified and his/her paper will be seized and not evaluated.

- 17.No special categories like Ex-Service men, Sports, Persons with Disability, etc., are not included.
- 18.Merit list for Counseling will be displayed in our Selection Committee Notice Board on the same day (07.12.2023).
